Encroachment Permits

- City regulations prohibit the keeping of more than four dogs without a kennel license.

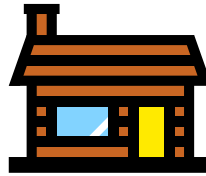
Refuse Collection

Curbside garbage and recycling collection is provided to City residents by Intermountain Disposal under an exclusive Franchise agreement. Weekly garbage and recyclable collection is mandatory for Occupied Residences within the City.

Commercial food preparation establishments are required to have garbage collected two times per week. Please contact Intermountain Disposal to start garbage service when you start your City utility service. The City provides notification when service is started.

Solid waste disposal services are also provided by Intermountain at their transfer station in Delleker.
